

An Unusual experience!

Today I was taking class for the first year B.Tech's, in CRC (Central Lecture Theatre) - 203 [1:00-1:50 slot]. I saw many students standing in the corridor. Went out and asked whether they did not have class that time. They told me that their PMT-Mech. Class was cancelled, and they were waiting for their maths class for the next slot in the same hall. Being the first semester students (they are only 10 days old in the campus!) I did not make them go away. I saw that many of them were very attentive to what I was lecturing (*convergence and divergence of sequences*).

After I finished my lecture, I took the "Rajdhani express" attendance: I started calling the roll numbers [AE-1,, 2, ... 58, BE-1, 2, ..., 27] of 85 students, keeping my head straight, moving the eyes to all parts of the hall to see the raising hands. After the completion of the roll call within two minutes, two-three students came to the platform to clarify their doubts; they did not want to ask during the lecture. Quickly, I clarified their doubts and started moving out of the hall so that the next teacher could enter. By that time all those who were in the corridor came in and occupied. **I saw that one of the boys who came to clarify the doubt was also among them!**

It was an unusual experience for me. Not only did he listened my lecture carefully (stading in the corridor) , but also wanted to clear his doubts!
